Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Englefield tapware.




NOTES:

1. Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.
2. Ensure all local plumbing codes are observed.
3. Recommended working pressure: 100kPa to 500kPa.
4. Maximum working pressure: 800kPa.
5. If pressure exceeds 500kPa, a pressure limiting valve must be installed.
6. All installations should comply with the relevant requirements of AS/NZS 3500.


ROUGH-IN



If you are building a bathroom from scratch, giving your bathroom a makeover or just replacing an old tap, Englefield can provide a solution for you.


INSTALLATION

- 1.) Insert the O-ring(1) into the base(2).
- 2.) Insert the base over the nipple.
- 3.) Apply thread sealant tape to the nipple.
- 4.) Screw the spout(3) firmly onto the pipe thread. Adjust as necessary to keep the base and spout level.



INSTALLATION CHECKOUT

- 1.) Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position.
- 2.) Open the bath drain as necessary. Turn on main water supply and check for leaks. Repair as required.
- 3.) Remove aerator(4). Turn on the bath spout. Run hot and cold water through spout for about one minute to remove any debris. Remove any debris from aerator. Shut off the bath spout and reinstall aerator.
